Your first golf course of the trip will be the **Kise Country Club**. Kise offers two different courses with 9 holes each. Their Ocean Course demands skilled techniques through its natural undulations of the courses amidst the panorama of emerald waters of the East China Sea. Offering a refreshing change of scenery and pace at the Woods Course, you can get out of the sun as you enjoy the course but do not be lulled by the tranquillity of its environs. Unexpected changes of scenery and land-scape will catch you unaware. So keep your eyes open and muscles limber!

**Day 03**

Okinawa has long since been one of the favourite golf destinations in Japan and over the course of these few days, you will get to understand why. **Southern Links Golf Club**, Okinawa's Number 1 golf course, reigns supreme bordering the Pacific Ocean, you have a good battle against the wind and sea up ahead. Onto your third and last golf course of the tour, you will enjoy another exhilarating course at the **Naha Golf Club**. While the terrain is relatively flat, strategically placed hazards and the unexpected sea breeze will challenge your concentration. Overcoming both the designed terrain and what nature throws at you are not going to be easy in this course. Good thing about playing here in Naha Golf Club is the breath-taking views of the dynamic Pacific Ocean that lets you relax while on play.

#### Day 02 (Wed, 22 Jun)

No visit to Okinawa will be complete without going to the Churaumi Aquarium. Ranked as one of Japan's best aquariums, this place is famous for its gigantic Kuroshio Tank that is home to some of the world's largest fishes. Two, yes, two whale sharks rule the tank with their graceful underwater dance, always accompanied by gasps of adults and children as they swim by and snaps of cameras, trying to capture this awesome moment forever. As Japan's southernmost point, Okinawa has a subtropical climate that gives rise to fruits that are very different from mainland Japan. Over at the Nago Pineapple Park, a theme park dedicated to all things pineapple, you can see over 100 different varieties of pineapples and all kinds of snacks ranging from juices, cakes to chocolates and even wines! We did not know that pineapples came in so many types and can be made into so many different products!

#### Day 03 (Thu, 23 Jun)

Starting with the scenic coastal theme today, you will have the opportunity to visit Cape Manzamo before heading to your hotel. This is one of Okinawa's most recognizable sights and its reputation is well-deserved. Facing the East China Sea, the 20-meter long limestone cliff that extends into the deep azure waters looks like an elephant's trunk. With the wide expanse of the grassy lawn atop this stunning landform, your camera is going to be overworked at this scenic spot. The great thing about doing a drive tour is how close you can get to the actual roads and topography of the places. Traversing the Kaichu Doro, you need to get ready for the many postcard-perfect moments as you drive through this 4.7km inter-island highway that slices through the azure waters that Okinawa is famed for. Unusual rock formations, immense rock caverns and ancient trees all work together to weave their magic over the visitors here.

#### Day 05 (Sat, 25 Jun)
