## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

# 1. Competition

- 1.1. *my golf kaki* May Medal, consisting of a single round of 18-holes, shall be played in **System 36, Stableford** format in accordance with the rules of golf as approved by the R & A and USGA.
- 1.2. Men shall tee off from white tees; Ladies as well as Juniors below 12 years old shall tee off from the red tees.
- 1.3. There is only ONE Open division:
- 1.4. All competitors are requested to register at least 30 minutes before your starting times.
- 1.5. All competitors shall report and be stationed at their respective T-boxes at least 15 minutes before tee-off time.
- 1.6. Play shall commence according to the designated tee-time.
- 1.7. In the interest of all players in the tournament, please ensure that your flight is able to keep up with the preceding flight. The tournament committee reserves the right to make suggestions to players and their flights to speed up play.
- 1.8. Players must adhere to golf course safety, etiquette and regulations. The tournament committee reserves the right to immediately disqualify golfers involved in dangerous play.
- 1.9. Please repair all divots, repair pitch marks and rake bunkers.
- 1.10. Please observe all local rules.

#### 2. Handicapping

- 2.1. Handicaps for all competitors shall be determined by the System 36, Stableford format.
- 2.2. Handicap index for all competitors shall play off as at 1<sup>st</sup> May 2019.

### 3. Conditions of Entry

- 3.1. All entries must have official USGA Handicap Index (Handicapping). Inactive members may be required to play at a lower Course Handicap than they would be entitled to if they were in the Active List.
- 3.2. Submission of entry is on a first-come-first-serve basis and confirmation of each entry is upon receipt of payment. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit, accept or reject entries and to allocate participants to different slots.
- 3.3. Once payment is received, there will be no refunds for withdrawal, cancellation or absenteeism.
- 3.4. For non-*my golf kaki* members, it is compulsory to show proof of golfer's insurance, failing which a daily golf insurance fee may be applicable.
- 3.5. Closing date for all entries is **26 April 2019**, Friday. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to change the closing date at its own discretion, and to postpone or cancel the competition in the event that the targeted number of participants is not reached or should any other circumstances arise.

### 4. Score Card Return

- 4.1. All competitors shall submit **GROSS** score only.
- 4.2. Score cards must be completed with signatures of the marker and player and returned to the Score Card Return Counter immediately upon completion of the round.

#### 5. Prizes

- 5.1. Participants are invited to attend a dinner and prize presentation.
- 5.2. Trophy and Prizes will be awarded to the top three Best Stableford scorers, and Overall Best Gross scorer.
- 5.3. Each participant will only be eligible for one tournament prize (trophy).
- 5.4. Only participants who are present during dinner are eligible for lucky draw prizes.

## 6. Countback

6.1. In the event of ties, the USGA Countback System shall apply.

## 7. Inclement Weather

- 7.1. In the event of inclement weather resulting in the inability of the tournament to continue, the Organizing Committee shall decide on the standings of the tournament. The Organizing Committee's decision shall be final.
- 7.2. In the event that 50 percent of the competition field cannot complete, then the game shall be declared null and void.
- 7.3. No rain checks will be given even if the golfers have not teed off the second 9-holes of their game.

#### 8. Disputes

- 8.1. Any complaints, protests or disputes shall be referred to the Organizing Committee for a decision and such decision shall be final.
- 8.2. Under no circumstances is *my golf kaki* and NCI Golf Pte Ltd to be held liable for any injury or death howsoever or wheresoever caused to any visitors or golfers, or for any loss or damage howsoever or wheresoever caused to the to the belongings or
- properties of the visitors or golfers. 8.3. The Organizing Committee shall reserve the right to amend the above Rules & Regulations.

## 9. Release Consent

- 9.1. By filling out this event registration form, the Lead Golfer confirms that all players named herein have fully understood and agreed to abide by all the terms and conditions as well as the privacy policy found on www.mygolfkaki.com. The Lead Golfer also consents to, and confirms that he/she has obtained consent from the players named herein, to *my golf kaki*'s collection, usage, disclosure or sharing of their personal data, including photograph or video, to *my golf kaki* and third parties for publicity and event participation purposes.
- 9.2. The Lead Golfer agrees and undertakes to notify *my golf kaki* if the players withdraw their consent to the use and disclosure of their personal data for this purpose, and to assist *my golf kaki* with all access requests and complaints which may be received from those individuals regarding the use of their personal data by *my golf kaki*.
- 9.3. Personal data may be used by *my golf kaki* in various publications and/or websites, and photos or videos may be cropped, edited, or retouched in any manner without further approval from you or the players.
- 9.4. Pairing list containing the names of golfers will be circulated to participants.
